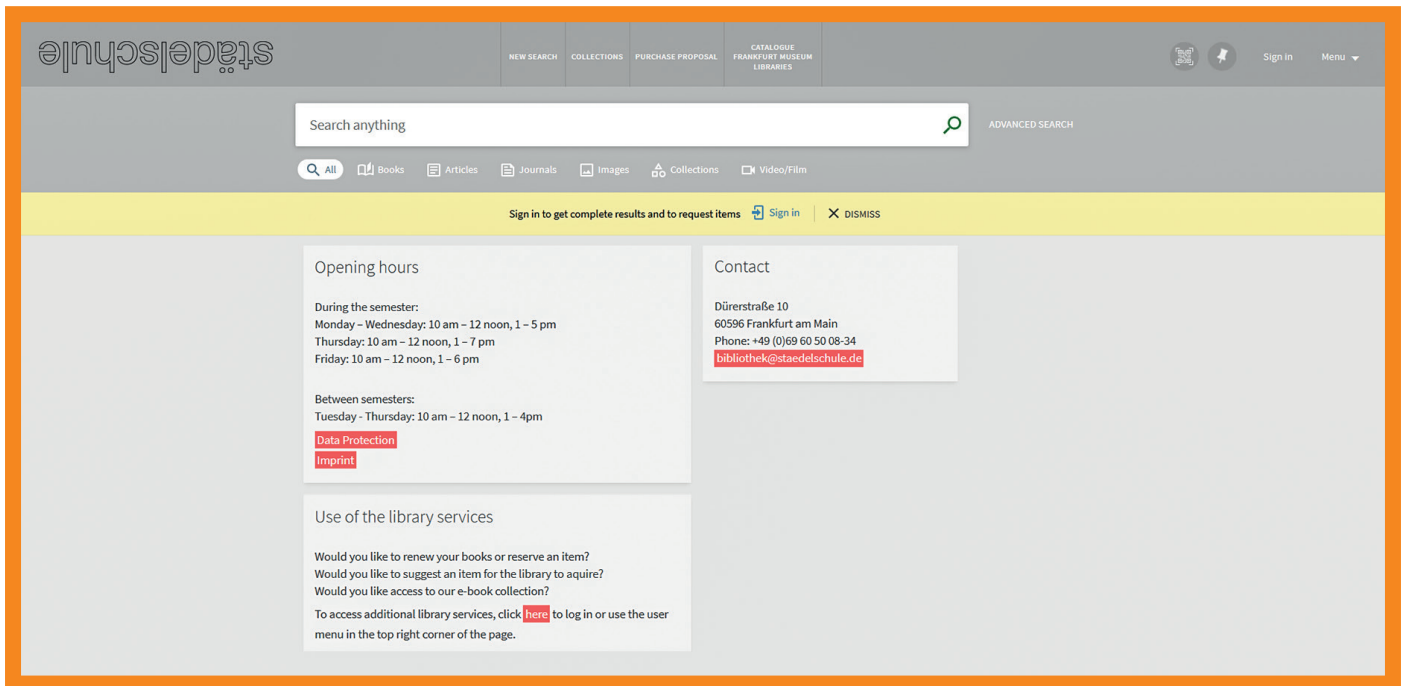


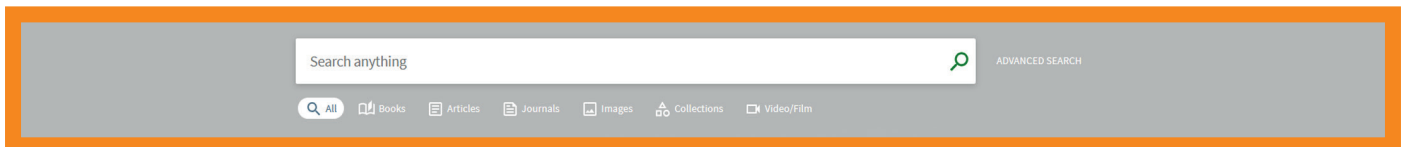

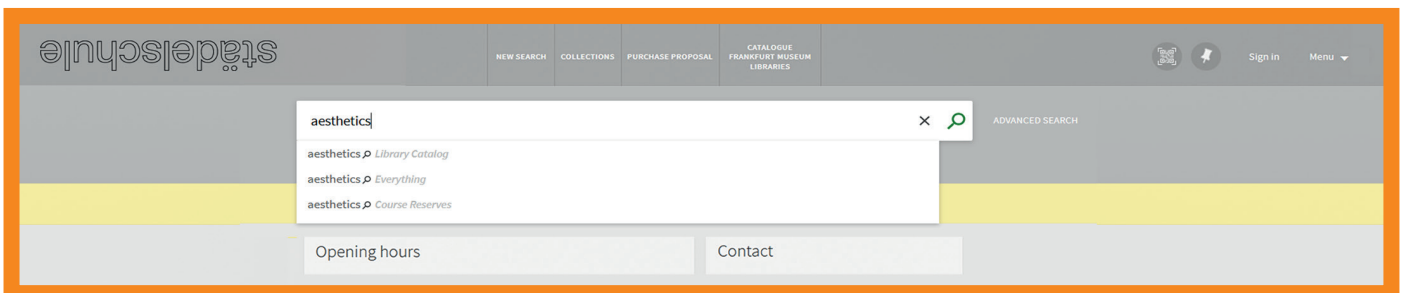
# 1. Please search our online catalogue via **Libcat.staedelschule.de**



You can search using a keyword, title, person or author. You can filter your search by resource type with the resource type filter bar.

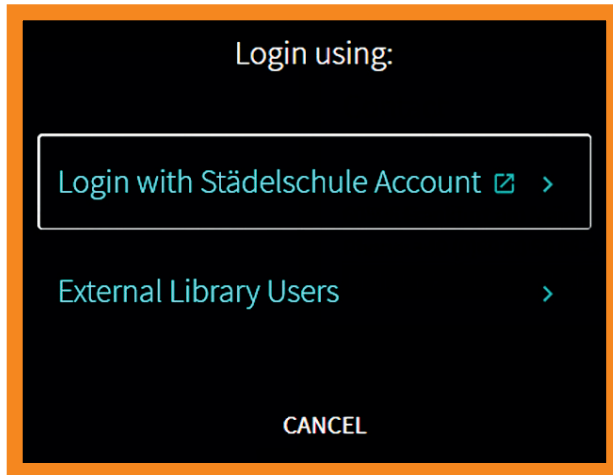


Once you type in a search term, a dropdown menu will open and you can limit the search to physical resources, available online, course reserves or simply everything.



Once you have the search results, you can filter by language, date of publication and further specific fields (title, author, subject, etc.). The advanced Search offers additional filter options.

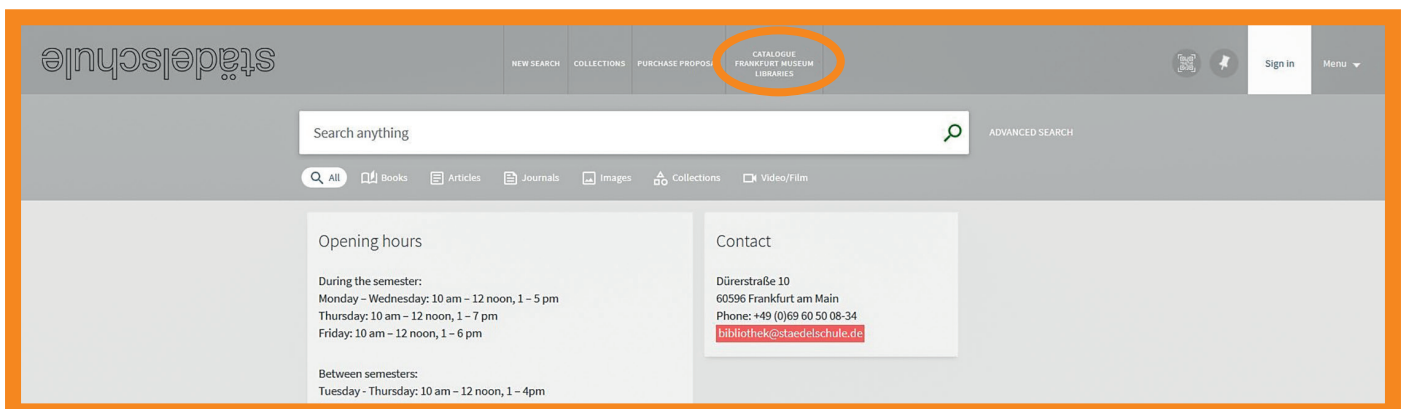
- 2.** You can log into your library account via **Sign in**, in the top right hand corner. You can log in with your Städelschule email and password. If you are an external user, please use the login **External Library Users**. User ID is your nominated email address. You must then create a password via **Password Reset**.



By clicking on your name in the top right hand corner, then **Library Card**, you can view your current loans, reservations and requests and renew your items. You can also request items from our closed stacks, which we will retrieve and place on our reservations shelf for you to collect.

- 3.** If we don't have what you're looking for, you can click on **Catalogue Frankfurt Museum Libraries** at the top of the screen and search the catalogues of almost 20 museum libraries in Frankfurt.

In addition to printed media, we also offer a wide range of digital information resources via our online catalog.

You can access most of the e-media directly. Please note that you must be logged into the Städel'schule's WiFi network on campus to access this material.

The exception to this rule is our ebook collection hosted by ProQuest, which you can access from outside of the Städel'schule environment.

All material hosted by ProQuest will be listed in the **Full text availability** box of the item's record as *Ebook Central Perpetual, DDA and Subscription Titles*.
