The Hochschule für Bildende Künste–Städelschule opens its doors at the end of the winter semester for the Rundgang – an extensive program of open studios, talks, performances and film screenings.

This year's Rundgang will take place from Friday, February 7 to Sunday, February 9, 2025, daily from 10:00–20:00 at both locations of the Städelschule.

The press reception will take place in the cafeteria at Daimlerstraße 32, followed by a guided tour through selected studios in the presence of students, and will continue at Dürerstraße 10. Programm

During the Rundgang, visitors can gain an insight into the artistic practice of students from all eight classes of the professors Monika Baer, Gerard Byrne, Benjamin Foerster-Baldenius, Judith Hopf, Hassan Khan, Tobias Rehberger, Willem de Rooij and Haegue Yang. The students open their studios and present their current work at both Städelschule locations. In cooperation with the DFF – Deutsches Filminstitut & Filmmuseum, film and video works by the students will also be shown in the museum's movie theatre.

In addition, Rundgang offers a rich program of performances, readings, concerts and talks. Students of *Curatorial Studies – Theory – History – Criticism*, a study program in cooperation with the Goethe University Frankfurt, invite artists, curators and other art professionals to discuss current topics of contemporary art. Current publications and editions by the Städelschule, Portikus and students are available for purchase in the library.
